The Stewards received a request from the organizer to reduce the length of the Pirelli GT4 America Sprint Race 1 from fifty minutes to forty five minutes.

Having reviewed the request. The Stewards approved the change following Article 5.2c of the sporting regulations from a maximum of 50 minutes to a 45 Minute Race.

**Article 5.2**

The Series is made up of Competitions consisting of two races with a maximum duration outlined for each case specified below. (For the avoidance of doubt, the two races at each event are considered as a single Competition for the purposes of these regulations.)

- a) Case A: 2 (two) races, each with a maximum duration of 90 (ninety) minutes – Not Applicable
- b) Case B: 2 (two) races, each with a maximum duration of 60 (sixty) minutes – GT4 SprintX
- c) Case C: 2 (two) races, each with a maximum duration of 50 (fifty) minutes – GT4 Sprint
- d) Case D: 2 (two) races, each with a maximum duration of 40 (forty) minutes – TC America
