Subject: Stewards Bulletin No. 007 - Alternate Qualifying Procedures per 2020 Sporting Note 1

Date: 9 July 2020

For 60 minute races (Case B), per TB-006 and Sporting Note #1, If a team desires to qualify an alternate chassis for a make-up race, the driver and chassis may qualify the alternative chassis in the session after the drivers normal session. The team is required to submit a request to and receive approval from the Stewards and the Race Director, and follow all technical inspection and Timing procedures 12 hours prior to the qualifying session.

If possible, the alternative chassis should carry a different car number than the race 1 and 2 chassis.

## An example of the Long Beach make-up at VIR race is as follows:

Official Request to Stewarts: 11:20 PM, Thursday July 9, 2020

Driver #1 Qualifying the Alternative chassis, in Driver 2 Session starting at 11:40

Per the rules Driver #1's **second** fastest time is this session sets the make-up race grid position for Race #3.

Race #3, Sunday July 10:00 AM, with alternative chassis, and driver #1 to start.
